

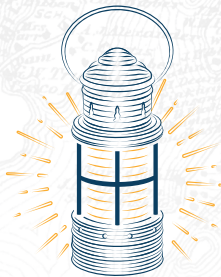
Changing Tools and Techniques History of Harpswell Fishing
